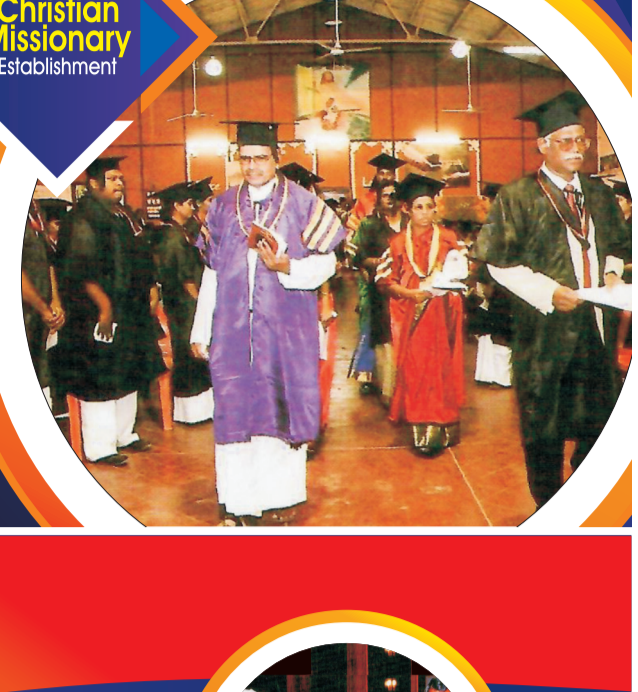

CSI AROGYAVARAM MEDICAL CENTER & MULTISPECIALTY HOSPITAL

Arogyavaram Medical Centre (AMC) was founded by Christian Missionaries from Europe during the Year 1912. The pioneers selected 350 acres of forest land in Madanapalle Town in Chittoor District of Andhra Pradesh and named the place as "Arogyavaram" meaning "Health, the Gift of God".

The land was then developed in to extremely elegant & well equipped 350 bedded Hospital buildings which were exclusively used for treating Tuberculosis (TB) patients in an era where treatment for a condition like that was not viable. The Hospital was inaugurated in the year 1915 by then the Governor of Madras, Lord Pentland and Dr. Christian Frimodt Moller lead the Hospital along with other European Doctors and Health Care Professionals.

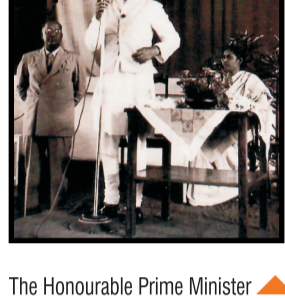
With the heritage and legacy the Hospital carried throughout the years have made this place as the Central Training centres in India for training Doctors and other Health Care Professionals for of the most vulnerable conditions like HIV/AIDS.

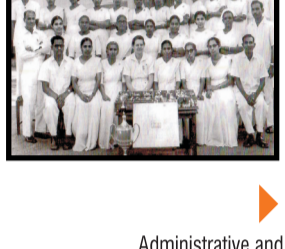
A glance to our Roots



The Honourable Prime Minister Dr. Jawaharlal Nehru's speech at CSI Arogyavaram Medical Centre Campus on 7th October 1952



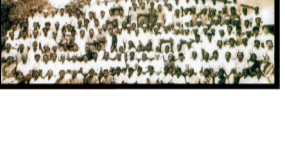

Administrative and other Staff - October 1975

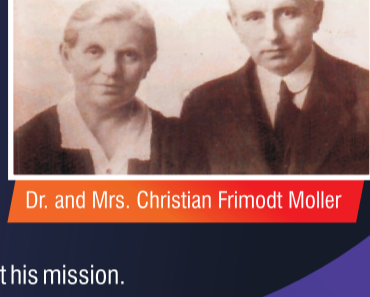


ABOUT OUR DIGNITARIES

Dr. Christian Frimodt Moller, a Danish Missionary Doctor who was the leader of a developed medical system in treating people with most vulnerable disease like TB and played a significant role in influencing the Medical System and lives of common people around the State. In 1939, he was appointed as the Medical Commissioner of Tuberculosis Association of India, New Delhi.

Rev. B. Rottschaefer, an architect and builder, who with his team of architects built the entire buildings and made extra ordinary infrastructure which transformed the place where there was no human habitation neither near or in the vicinity.

MILE STONES

- 1912: The pioneers selected 350 acres of forest land & laid the stone for Sanatorium. This place was called as "Arogyavaram" meaning, Health the gift of God
- 1915: The Union Mission tuberculosis Sanatorium was started to treat TB patients in an isolated area as 'Sanatoria treatment' & this was the first sanatorium in South India
- 1920: The Domiciliary care of TB was advocated by this institution
- 1922: The first Thoracoplasty operation in India was done at this centre
- 1927: Laboratory Technician course was started
- 1947: The pioneering survey for TB in the region was taken up by this institution in response to the government of India's request to study the immediate effect of BCG vaccination in Indian Children and a research unit called "Madanapalle Tuberculosis Research Unit" (MTRU) was started
- 1950: The first Post Graduate course in Tuberculosis (TDD) in India was started. The Former Medical Superintendents were chosen as advisors in TB to the Government of India
- 1955: Smt. Rajkumari Amrit Kaur, the first Health Minister of India opened the TB Children hospital on 19.07.1955
- 1975: The Union Mission Tuberculosis Sanatorium was converted into Arogyavaram Medical Centre as a general hospital with 350 beds
- 1987: Society is renamed as CSI Arogyavaram Medical Centre with new Constitutional Byelaws with the majority of members from CSI Royalaseema Diocese
- Dr. B. Wesley is appointed as the Director and Mrs. Sheela Wesley as the Nursing Superintendent
- 1995: Started Diploma in Radiography course.
- 1999: School of Nursing was started in this year
- 2000: Hosted National Conference of SNA / TNAI
- 2000: Started a Care and Support Centre to provide wholistic care for the HIV AIDS patients
- 2002: Care and Support centre was started initially with 10 beds to deliver holistic health, counsell and rehabilitation for the PLWHAS
- 2002: Government of Andhra Pradesh has issued the Essentiality Certificate to start a Medical College at Arogyavaram Medical Centre
- 2006: College of Nursing was started in this year
- 2007: Arogyavaram Medical Centre is selected as one of the 4 training centers in India to train Doctors, Nurses and Pastors every year in HIV/AIDS
